

Interactive video at St. Boniface General Hospital

One of the highlights of the February 13th MHLA meeting to be held in the Nursing Education wing of St. Boniface General Hospital is the demonstration of the Helene Fuld Library's IVD (Interactive Video Disc) courseware after the general meeting. But what exactly is Interactive Video and how does it differ from CAI (Computer Aided Instruction)?

Interactive video is a fairly recent technology which combines text files, graphics, and system software on a microcomputer with "live" (action) video and audio information recorded on video (laser) discs. These are the same discs sold commercially with digitized recordings of *Born on the fourth of July* or Mozart's *Don Giovanni*. Commercial laserdiscs, though, are meant to be played in a serial fashion, in much the same way as a videocassette or film, with video and audio tracks playing back images in the same order in which they were recorded. With IVD, sequencing of playback is controlled by the computer with direction being given by the human at the keyboard or touchscreen. The computer also has the ability to bring additional information in from its hard disk to overlay the video sequences on the screen. These overlays may be questions to be answered or branch routes to take in one's programmed course of learning. They may also be hypertext-like "buttons" leading to dictionaries, charts, and tables. In any case the user is able to progress through the programme at their own rate and even to keep score on themselves in many packages.

In AJN's *Care of the elderly patient with chronic obstructive pulmonary disease*, professional actors are used to demonstrate characteristics of a typical patient at the admission, diagnosis, treatment, and discharge stages. The student at the IVD workstation takes vital signs, looks for symptoms, consoles a distraught spouse, administers medication and generally performs the gamut of nursing functions without ever touching the patient. Incorrect responses to queries are noted and the correct response is detailed. The whole session may last anywhere up to a couple of hours, depending on the knowledge of the user and the number of modules they explore. Concepts not understood may be

looked up in the "library", a dictionary and textbook of terms and text not unlike that found in a reference collection.

Besides COPD, the Helene Fuld Library currently owns three other IVD titles: NIMH's *The suicidal adolescent*, Hocking (Ohio) Technical College's *Intravenous therapy*, and the Training Group's *First and second heart sounds*. Some of these titles have already been used both in SBGH's RN programme and for some University of Manitoba nursing courses. Several other programmes have been received for preview as well. Student reaction has been quite favourable and research is also underway to determine the tool's value in the nursing curriculum.

The two IVD workstations in the Helene Fuld Library were received as part of a grant programme administered by the Fuld Institute for Technology in Nursing Education (FITNE) to seed nursing schools with the technology needed to use IVD and thus develop a market for potential producers of IVD courseware. Some 80 systems were given away to 46 sites all over North America. The experiment seems to have borne fruit as a number of vendors have produced a wide variety of packages over the last two years.

To learn more and see for yourself, be sure to come to the February meeting of MHLA, to be held in the Parlour on the 1st floor of the Nursing Education Building.

Finding health information on Bridge

The monograph collections of St. Boniface General Hospital and the University of Manitoba's thirteen libraries have been accessible for quite some time now by dial-up access or directly through UMNETH, the campus network. And while it is not possible to find article-level information about periodicals, one can determine holdings of particular journal titles held at the two institutions.

To access Bridge from your library you only need to have a computer, communications software like *Procomm*, *Crosstalk*, or *Smartcom*, and a 300, 1200 or 2400 baud modem. To get into Bridge set your communications software for Even parity, 7 data bits, 1 stop bit and echo on and then dial one of the UMNETH numbers (275-6100, 6110, 6120, etc.). If after connecting your screen is still blank try hitting the <ENTER> key a few times. Once the UMNETH prompt is on screen just type bridge (echo will make it look funny) <ENTER>, followed by BE <ENTER> and you are in. Since you are dialing into the University's network your searches will default to their holdings only. To also see SBCGH holdings (and anyone else who may join later) type LIB SYS. For help at any time simply type the word HELP or HELP TE (or other command) to find help on doing term (or other) searches. Search commands are prefixed by a two letter code which may be from the following list:

- TE Term search- a keyword search on specified words taken from subjects, titles (including series), notes, and authors; useful if you don't know the vocabulary of the subject indexing system used or if you don't retrieve much using a more exact search query
TE breast cancer
- TI Title search- a search on the first 4 significant words of a title
TI critical care nursing clinics
- TT Title term search- search using keywords from the title index
TT recent advances nursing 23
- AU Author search- by exact name, surname first
AU nightingale florence
AU canadian dental association
- SU Subject search- by exact subject heading, either LC or MeSH
SU breast neoplasms
- ST Subject term search- search by any keywords found in subject heading fields in a record
ST directories canada

If you know the subject headings or LC/NLM classification scheme in your field of interest pretty well you may want to try browsing around in the indexes for materials of interest. BR CA WS107 will allow you to browse Bridge for material on Retarded

children classified by NLM number. BR SU hospital will allow you to see how many postings are in the system for any subject heading starting with the word "Hospital". BR AU pittsburg will let you see the author index in the vicinity of a name you aren't too sure of the spelling or forename of.

Naturally, finding an item in an online catalogue is one thing and actually laying your hands on the book or serial is another. Fortunately, it is also possible to see whether or not the title is checked out and which issues of a periodical have been checked in. DS (display status) will bring up a listing of the actual "items" associated with a title-the issues of a journal or the copies of a book. While this doesn't guarantee that the item isn't wandering around the building somewhere, it is often enough to base an ILL request on. Summary holdings of periodicals may also be seen as notes on the records held by the Medical and Dental Libraries at the U of M and by the SBCGH libraries.

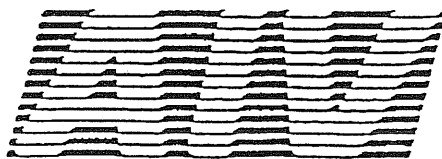
Union Book Catalogue moves to HSC

So it might be helpful to know that two AV distributors have representatives and free preview facilities right here in Winnipeg.

Medical Video Library

Its collection of 120 videotapes is geared mainly to patient education and deals with the promotion of good health, recognition of the signs of illness and knowing what to do about them. The tapes are produced in conjunction with the Faculty of Medicine, University of Toronto and provide patients with practical, useful medical information in clear and simple language everyone can understand. These shows, all ten minutes in length, are documentary in style, they portray real patients experiencing real medical situations and cover a variety of topics, e.g. Cardiology, Pediatrics, Diabetes, Mental health, Oncology, Gerontology, Orthopedics, Surgery, etc.
