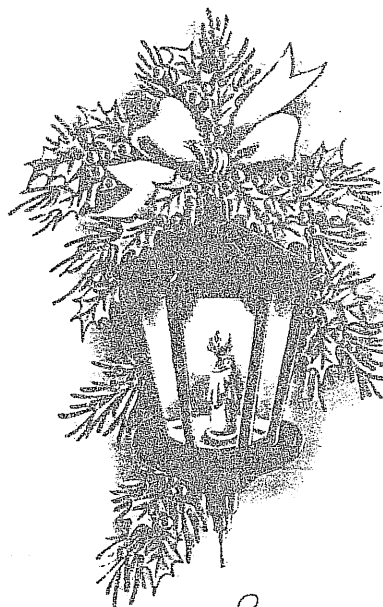

CHLA/ABSC UPDATE

Canadian Health Libraries Association
Annual Meeting June 13-15, 1983

The 1983 CHLA conference promises to be exciting and informative, with outstanding speakers and a theme of interest to all members. The first day is assigned to Continuing Education courses which will be publicized when the topics have been chosen.

The theme of the conference focuses on the importance of, and concern about, Rights and Responsibilities.

The keynote address will be given by Dr. Daniel LeTouzé, Vice-President of the Canadian Hospital Association.

An overview of the theme will be presented by a panel discussion on the legal and ethical issues in health information and will include a lawyer, clergyman, librarian, physician, and author as citizens' advocate.

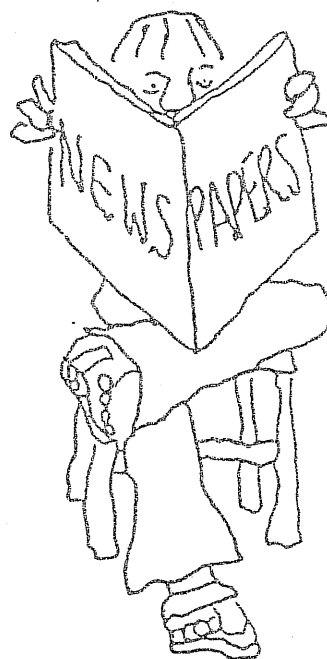
Getting down to specifics will consist of health professionals discussing their role in the provision of information to patients. Participants will include a physiologist, dentist, pharmacist, nurse clinician, and clinical librarian.

Putting it all together concentrates on libraries in the following fields with speakers representing the public library, government health libraries, libraries in community health agencies, and patients' libraries, and their role in providing health information. The annual general meeting will be held following the sessions. The social

program includes a wine and cheese reception at the Winnipeg Art Gallery, and a banquet at the Winnipeg Chamber of Commerce Dining Room, followed by entertainment by several of the cultural groups who perform at Folklorama.

On the day following the meeting, all visitors will be welcome to tour the various local health libraries.

All MHLA members are urged to help make the meeting the most successful ever by planning to attend and participating in the activities.

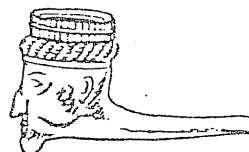
