J.W. CRANE MEMORIAL LIBRARY GRAND OPENING

Canada's largest and most comprehensive special library on aging - the J.W. Crane Memorial Library, enjoyed its official grand opening at Deer Lodge Centre January 30th, 1992.

The opening culminated months of preparation beginning in the spring when the Toronto based Canadian Geriatrics Research Society donated the J.W. Crane Memorial Library of Geriatrics and Gerontology to Deer Lodge Centre. The library was named after the late Dr. J.W. Crane, founding dean of medicine at the University of Western Ontario, whose personal collection formed the nucleus of the library.

In what was considered a coup for Deer Lodge Centre, over 4300 books, 1670 articles reprints, vertical file materials and audio cassettes and a periodical index of 15,000 articles arrived at the Centre adding to the DLC library's already substantial acquisitions.

The impressive collection and extensive resources of the new Crane Library at Deer Lodge, including computer searches, reference and lending services have resulted in the creation of a national resource here in Winnipeg. As a result Librarian Consultants Judy Inglis and Laurie Blanchard, along with Library Technicians Janice Saunders and Christine Shaw-Daigle are faced with the challenge of responding to a wide range of requests comming from across the country and beyond. Other geriatric facilities in Winnipeg

and rural Manitoba have particularly benefited from the proximity of the new Crane Library.

Considerable effort and expense went into preparing the library for service, and the main contributors were recognized at the grand opening. The Canadian Geriatrics Research Society (CGRS), the Energy and Chemical Workers Union and the Winnipeg Foundation were acknowledged as major contributors.

The grand opening ceremony included messages from Hon. Don Orchard, Mayor Bill Norrie, Ken Whiteside of CGRS, Mary Jane McIntyre, Chair of the Deer Lodge Centre Foundation and Hugh McGrath, Chair of Deer Lodge Centre Board of Directors. Tours of the exciting new library followed the official ribbon cutting.

THE RED CROSS HAS A LIBRARY!

The Canadian Red Cross Society is a volunteerbased organization which provides emergency relief and humanitarian service to the public through the operation of national blood service. The Blood Transfusion Service of the Canadian Red Cross in Winnipeg houses a small special library in the field of blood banks, blood transfusions and related medical areas. Tucked away in an office at the end of a long corridor of blood testing and research laboratories, the collection consists of approximately monographs and 30 serials subscriptions, and serves the staff and researchers of the Winnipeg Branch.

Unfortunately, over time and with continued growth the collection has become disorganized. No attempt at cataloguing or classification of the materials has been made. There has been no weeding of materials, some dating back as far as the 1940's. Because of these problems, this extensive collection has received little notice or use.

Since March 16th, Ryan Schultz, a volunteer librarian, has come in several hours per week to analyze and organize this collection. The goal of this project is to improve the in-house and ILL access to this valuable hematological collection. The work so far consists of two parts. First is a physical reorganization of the library materials by format (serials, monographs, conference proceedings, annual reports, newsletters, etc.). Second is an evaluation of microcomputer-based library systems to control the acquisitions, cataloguing and circulation of materials.

Work is proceeding slowly but steadily. Response of the Red Cross staff to a preliminary reorganization has been very good. A microcomputer with a hard drive has been obtained and set up, and evaluation of library software packages has begun. Further information on this library collection can be obtained from:



COMPUTER ASSISTED INSTRUCTION AT ST. BONIFACE HOSPITAL

In December 1991, a Computer Based Learning Centre ("Computer Lab" for short) opened at St. Boniface General Hospital. At present, the Centre contains three Interactive Video Workstations, six PC's, and one Apple IIe. A printer is networked to all PC's. The courseware used is all interactive and consists of Interactive Video Disks (IVD's) and Computer Assisted Instruction programs (CAI's).

The response to computer based instruction has been positive. Students and faculty say that 24-hour a day access to the Centre's menu-driven courseware reduces many of the barriers to utilization. Faculty who have little or no exposure to computers find access and use easier than they had initially anticipated. They have begun to use computer assisted instruction as a teaching strategy, and students who have had no previous experience with computers are eager to come back and try more.
